TRIP OVERVIEW

- Meet-up: Freetown, Sierra Leone (April 2027)
- Departure: Monrovia, Liberia (April 2027)
- Group size: ~12 participants
- This is not a "voluntourism" trip. AMI intentionally designs this experience around ethical, sustainable, and community-led development. Participants learn about sustainable agriculture and food security, youth development and leadership, women's empowerment and girls' education, and community-led solutions to poverty and economic injustice.
- Participants complete an online learning component before travel.



- Trip Cost: \$7,000 per participant. ** This covers all in-country expenses for the journey, including lodging, meals, local transportation, and coordination across Sierra Leone and Liberia. Participants are responsible for their round-trip international airfare (est. \$3,000) and visa fees (est. \$400).

Any amount contributed above the actual trip cost is a tax-deductible contribution that directly supports AMI's ongoing programs with rural women farmers, youth leaders, and community partners across West Africa.
